College/Major Notes:

Background checks are required of all HDFE majors. Students may be required to complete background checks in both the College of Human Sciences and the College of Education.

Students completing the dual objective program earn the Bachelor of Science in HDFS and are eligible for the Alabama Class B Teacher Certification.

Students must meet the College of Education's requirements for admission. Admission requirements are stated in the AU Bulletin.

ALL HDFS/HDFE students at the sophomore level or higher will be assessed a small yearly fee for professional liability insurance. All Human Sciences majors are required to have a laptop computer. Please refer to the CHS website for specifications.
