



Nursery Technician – Hazelhurst, Mississippi

We have an exciting opportunity for a **Nursery Technician** at the **Pearl River Nursery**—a state-of-the-art facility located 20 miles east of **Hazelhurst**, **Mississippi**. This is a small town of approximately 5,000 people nestled in Copiah County in southwest Mississippi. Nearby towns include Wesson and Crystal Springs. Points of interest include historic Jackson, Vicksburg and Natchez, and the Gulf Coast is only a few hours away. In this position, you will work on a team of seven employees at the Pearl River Nursery, and two **Nursery Technicians** at the River Bend Nursery. The Nursery Technician at both nurseries report directly to the Pearl River Nursery Supervisor.

As a **Nursery Technician** you will support the production of 55 million containerized southern pine seedlings annually and have the opportunity to develop your skills in planting, irrigation, fertilizer/chemical application and harvesting. This is your chance to develop the full spectrum of experience in each season. In the spring, your focus will be preparation and planting. In the summer, you will shift your efforts to growing, fertilizing and irrigation. In the winter, you will be involved in the development and harvest of our seedling crop. To ensure a well-rounded understanding, you will learn how to maintain the necessary equipment and buildings.

Plum Creek's loblolly and slash pine seedlings are positioned to be some of the highest quality in the industry and are distributed across five states in the Southeast including GA, FL, AL, SC, and MS. Our efforts are focused on high quality seedlings with good survivability and growth characteristics.

- Knowledge of maintenance, calibration, and operation of related equipment, including: fertilizer and pesticide applicators, specialized nursery equipment, heavy equipment, and refrigeration units.
