Article 2: Membership

The University Faculty shall consist of all positions of professorial status and other positions that have a primary academic function associated with Auburn University, main campus. Academic function generally is defined as having a primary responsibility for supervising or administering an academic program or for academic participation in an academic program. The academic program of the University is understood to include instruction, research, and extension. University Faculty is subdivided into tenured and non-tenured groups.

A. Except as provided in paragraph B of this Section the voting members of the University faculty are those faculty members holding the rank of:

professor, 50% appointment or greater
research professor, 50% appointment or greater
clinical professor, 50% appointment or greater
Librarian IV, 50% appointment or greater
Archivist IV, 50% appointment or greater
associate professor, 50% appointment or greater
research associate professor, 50% appointment or greater
clinical associate professor, 50% appointment or greater
Librarian III, 50% appointment or greater
Archivist III, 50% appointment or greater
assistant professor, 50% appointment or greater
research assistant professor, 50% appointment or greater
clinical assistant professor, 50% appointment or greater
Librarian II, 50% appointment or greater
Archivist II, 50% appointment or greater
county agents
Alabama Cooperative Extension System personnel classified as non-tenure track faculty
Alabama Agricultural Experiment Station personnel classified as non-tenure track faculty
Outreach personnel classified as non-tenure track faculty
full-time instructor
full-time Librarian I
full-time Archivist I
full-time principal lecturer
full-time senior lecturer
full-time senior artist in residence

full-time lecturer

full-time artist in residence

a retired assistant professor, associate professor, or professor during the term(s) he or she is serving on a part-time basis

a retired research assistant professor, research associate professor or research professor during the term(s) he or she is serving on a part-time basis

a retired clinical assistant professor, clinical associate professor, or clinical professor during the term(s) he or she is serving on a part-time basis

B. Notwithstanding the rank held, the following are not voting members of the faculty:

persons serving under visiting appointments;

persons on leave of absence;

persons serving under affiliate appointments;

persons of emeritus status unless serving on a part-time basis;

persons serving under adjunct appointments insofar as their adjunct appointments are concerned.
