Ballots on Matters Other Than Elections

Motions, resolutions, or other matters presented for a University Faculty vote shall be discussed at a regularly scheduled University Faculty meeting or in a special meeting called in accordance with Article 4, Section 2 of the University Faculty constitution. Within three days of the meeting, the secretary shall send the voting faculty instructions for casting ballots. The instructions shall include the text of the proposal, arguments for and against the proposal from the previous meeting, and the dates of the voting period. The faculty shall have five calendar days to vote on the proposal. In order for the proposal to pass, it must receive an affirmative majority vote of the members voting. On the first working day following the voting period, the secretary and secretary-elect will certify the results of the ballot and inform the faculty of the results.
