



Auburn University-Main Campus Proposed FY11 Total Budget - \$744M



More Auxiliaries

- Auxiliary funds
 - Self-supporting
 - Each auxiliary assessed 6.3% for administrative costs



All Divisions – Salary Supplement

- One-time merit-based salary supplement to be paid in December, 2010
- Eligibility regular/continuing employee prior to June 1, 2010
- Based on documented performance appraisals
- Individual supplements at 0-6% of base salary



All Divisions – Salary Supplement

- Allocation to Colleges/VPs 4% on filled and eligible positions on base budget funds
- Source general fund balances, auxiliary funds and other soft funds
- Divisional breakdown
 - AU \$13.7M
 - AUM \$1.8M
 - AAES-\$1.3M
 - ACES-\$1.5M

Stimulus

Final year of <u>State Fiscal Stabilization Funds</u> (SFSF)

Allocated primarily to academic units to offset impact of budget reductions

Main campus allocation of \$16.9M

Chemical storage system	\$873K

Outlook

- After budget was prepared 2% proration announced for FY10 \$5.2M impact
- In FY11 Stimulus will offset budget reductions in academic units
- Proration of FY11 State appropriation is possible and depending on amount, further one-time budget reductions may be necessary
