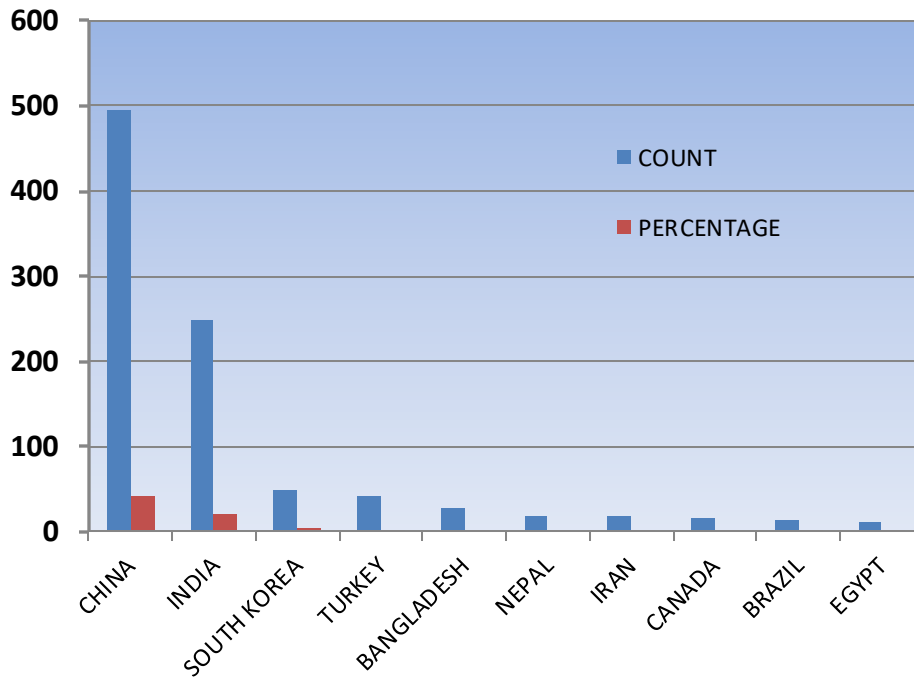

**Graduate students: 1053**

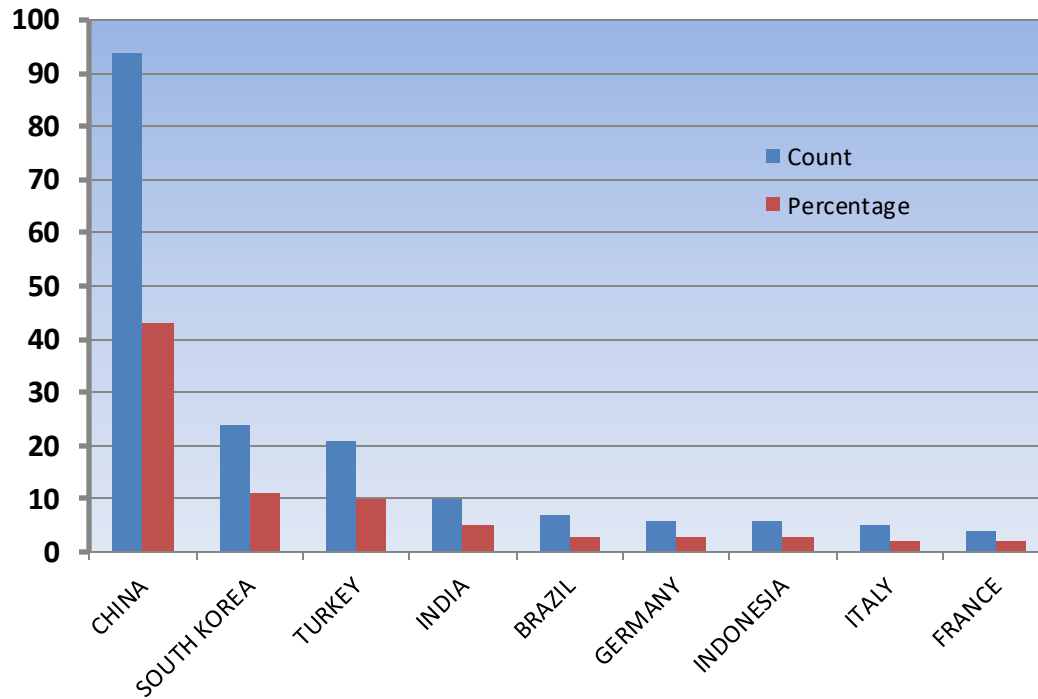
**Undergraduate students: 122**

# The Intensive English Program

- International Student/Scholar English Center – tutoring at no charge
  - 45-60 hours of tutoring per week, and growing
  - 58% grad students; 27% scholars; 14% IEP students; 1% undergrad students
- English for Everyday Use – informal class for scholars, spouses, students
- IEP students: 111
  - About 10% matriculate into AU degree programs, but improving
  - 11 countries represented; Top countries are Saudi Arabia, South Korea, Japan, China, Turkey

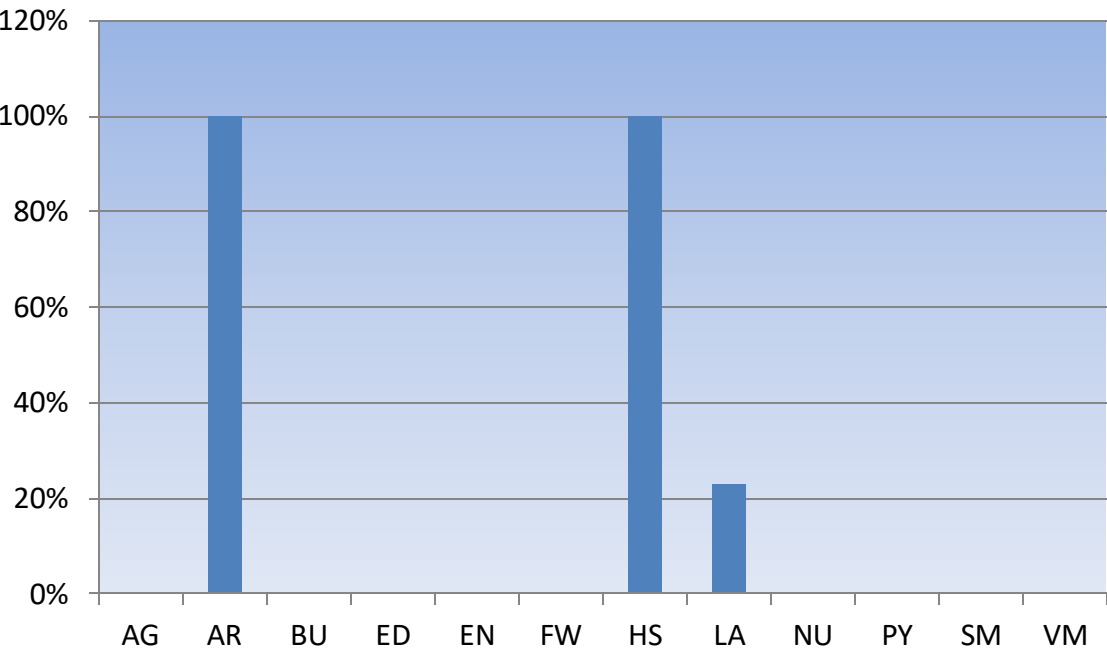




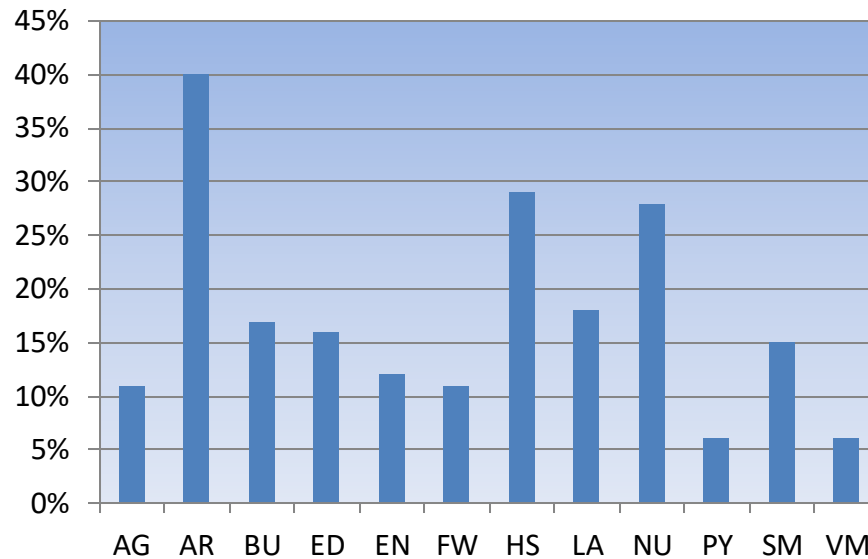
# Departmental Undergraduate/Professional Study Abroad

## Undergraduate Cohort Study Abroad



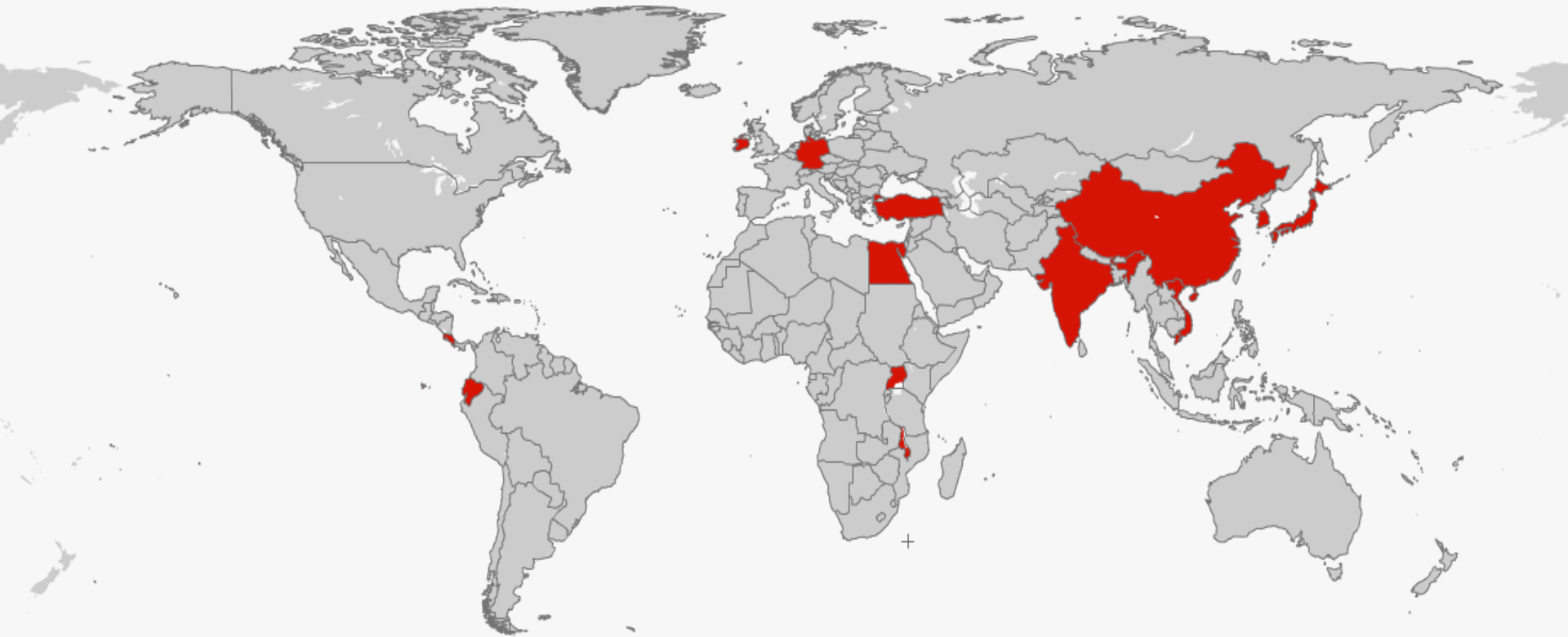

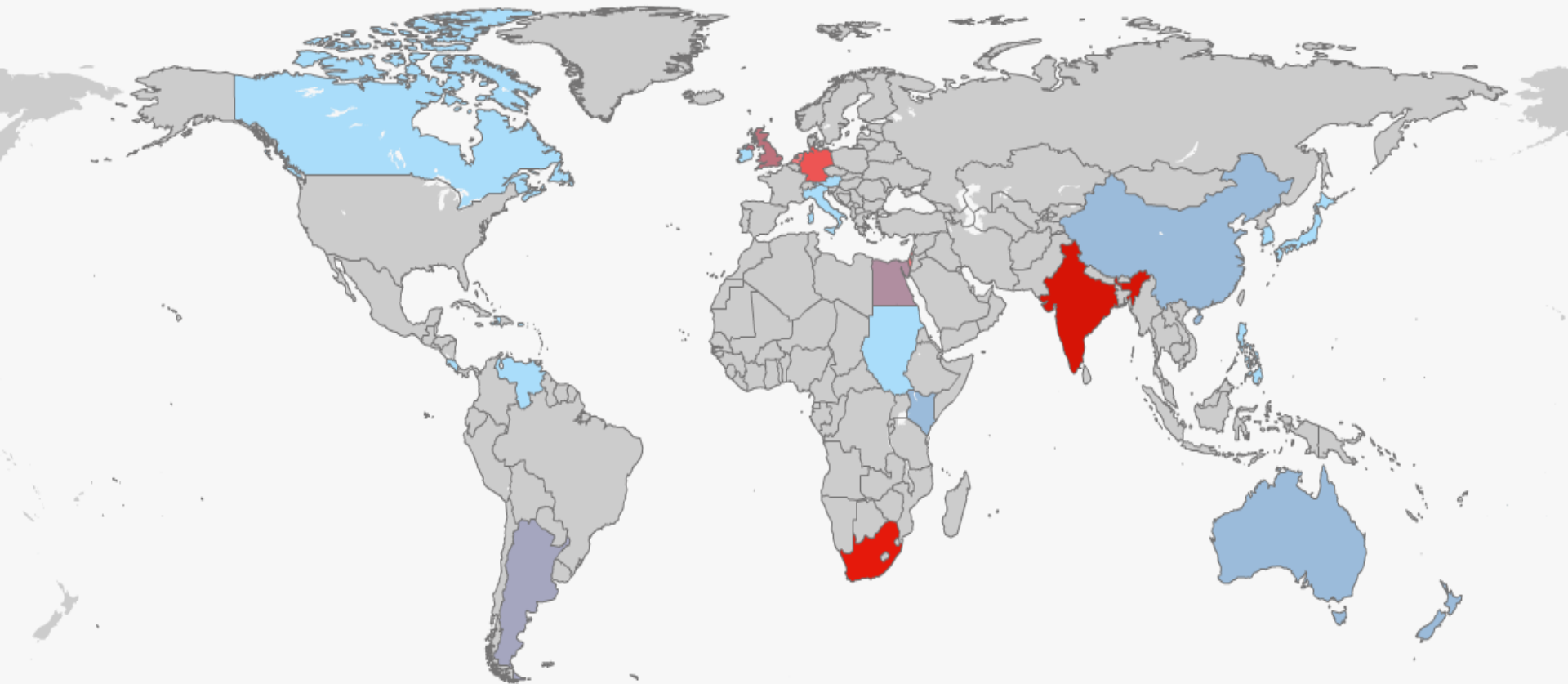

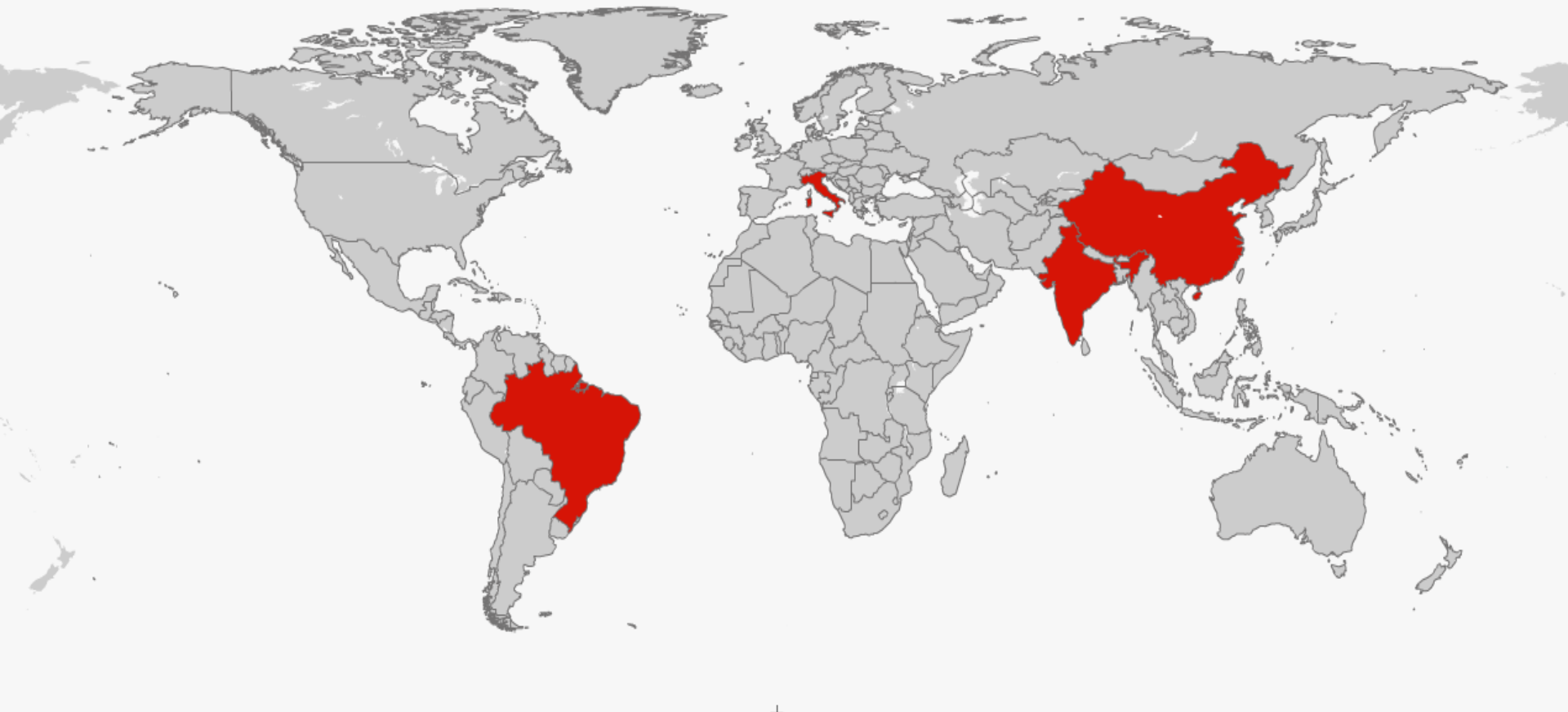
