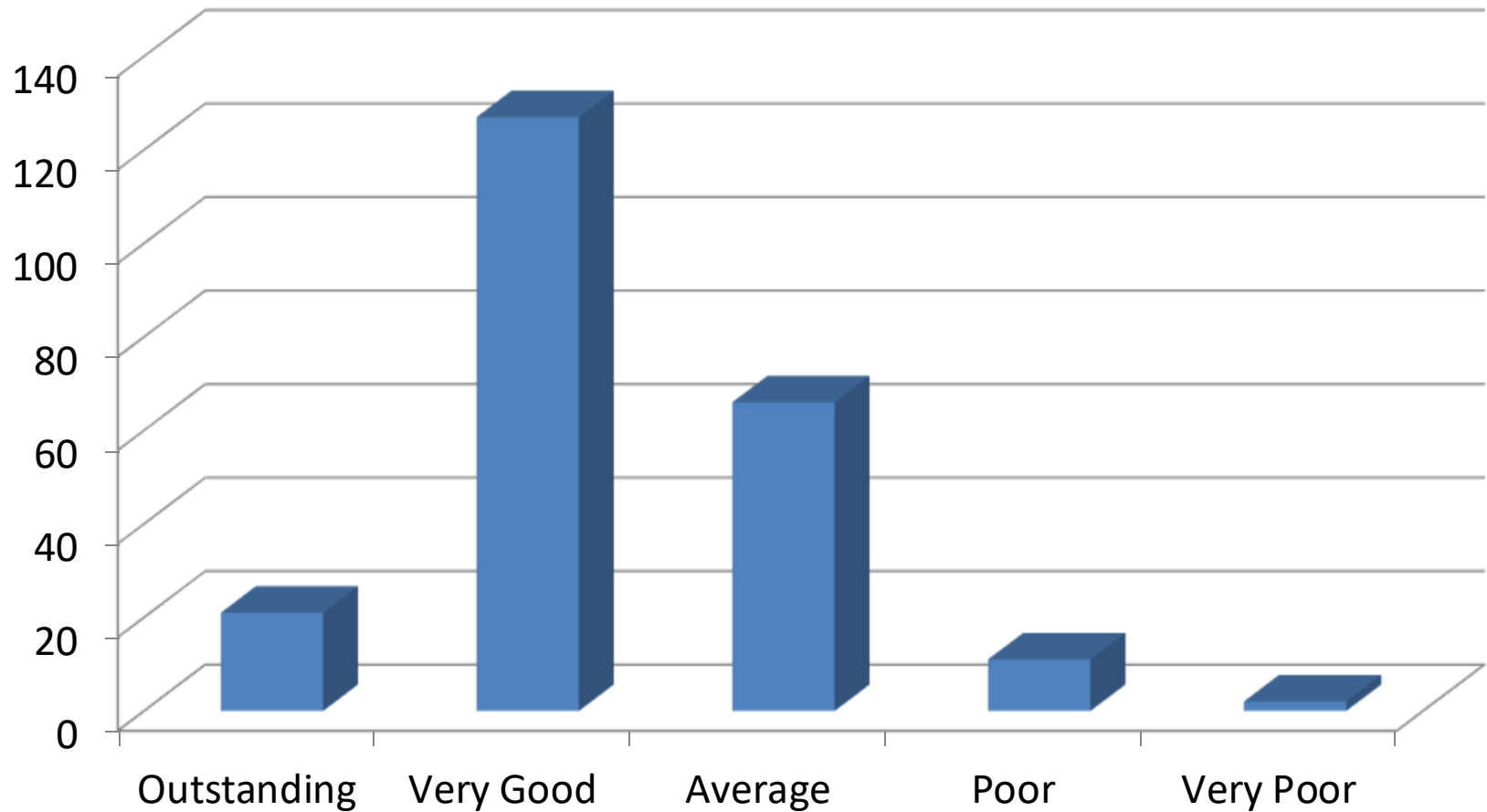
If I could change one thing:

- More paper journals - 6

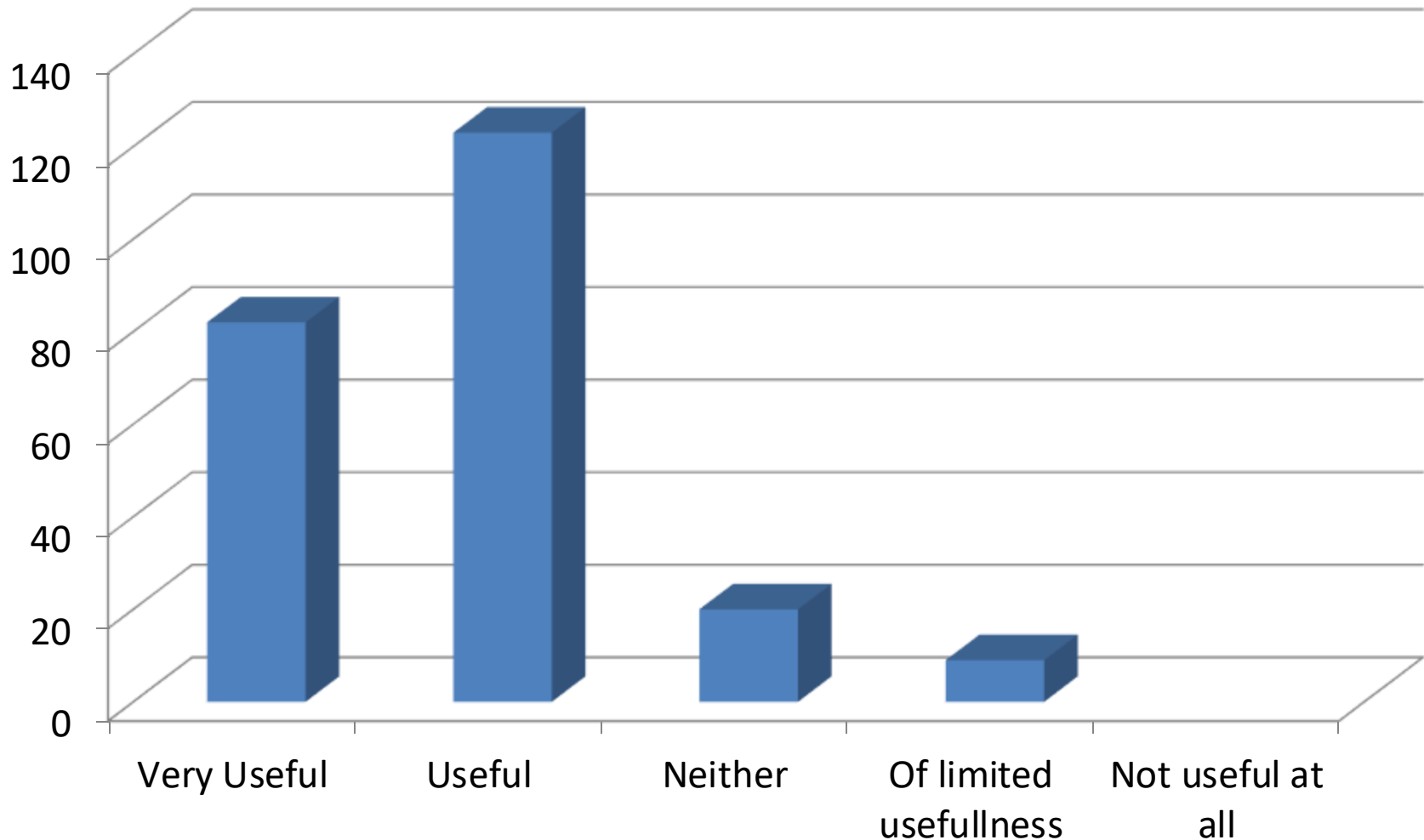
Looking forward, I will need the following from the libraries:
