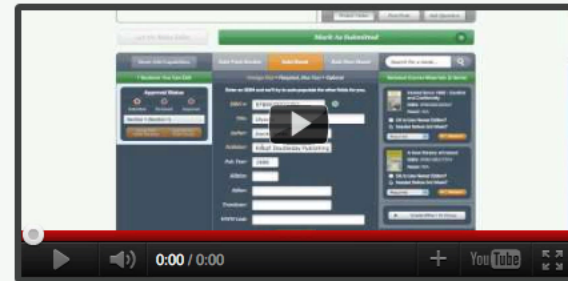
- ⌘ Addresses the need for more on-time adoptions from faculty and improves communication to ensure Bookstore has received and processed each order.
