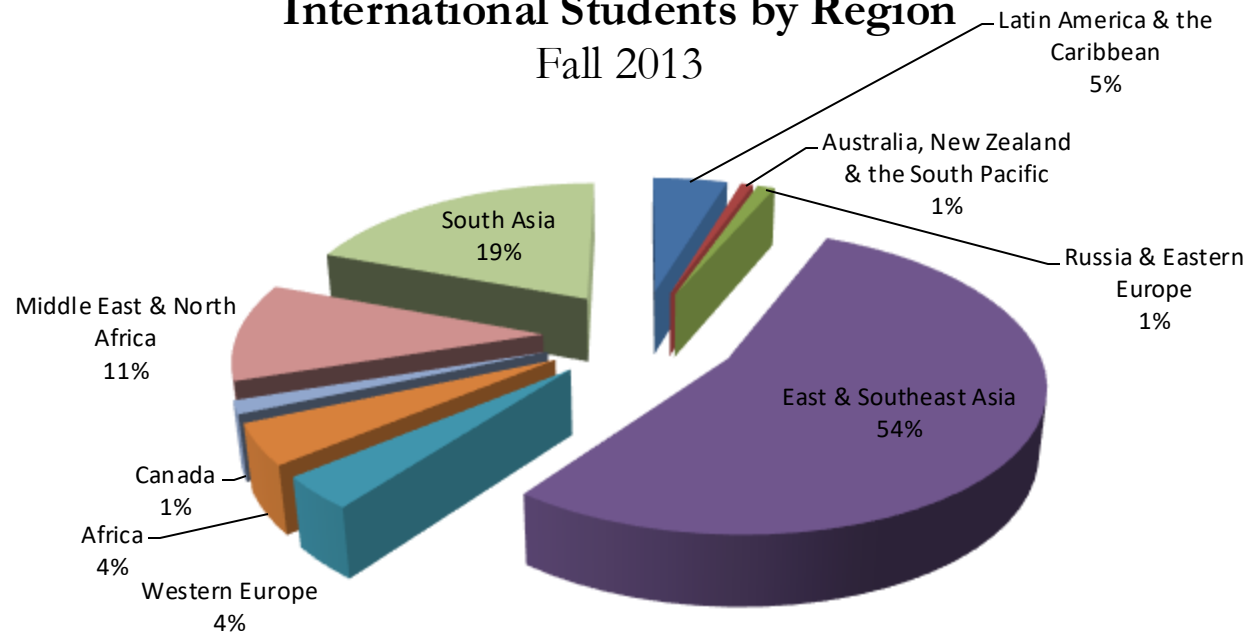

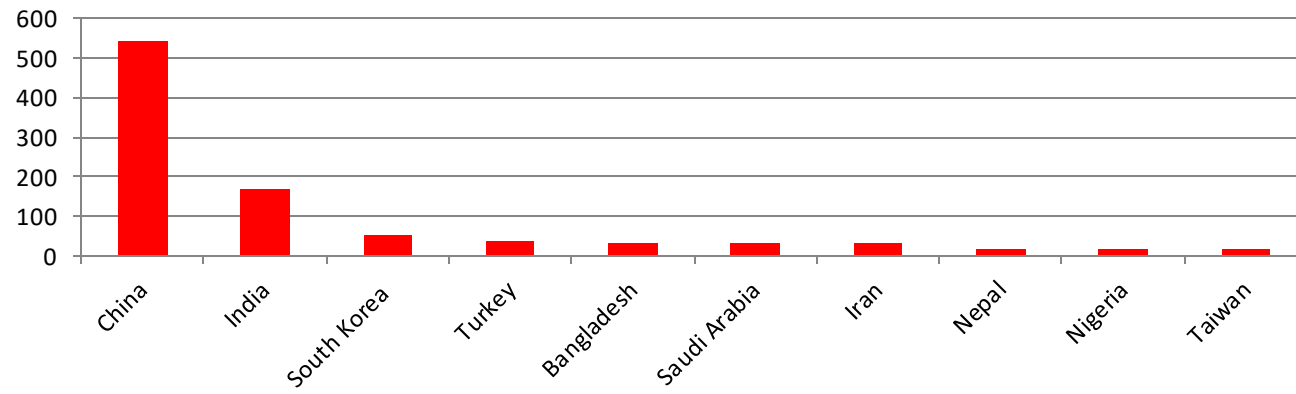

International Students by Region Fall 2013



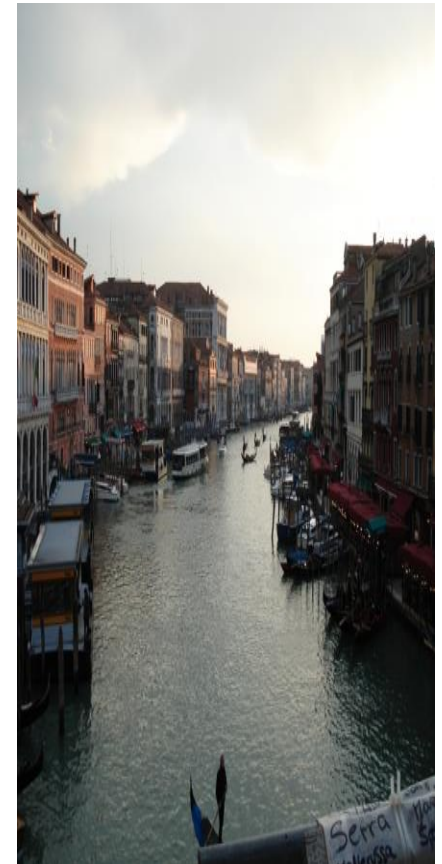
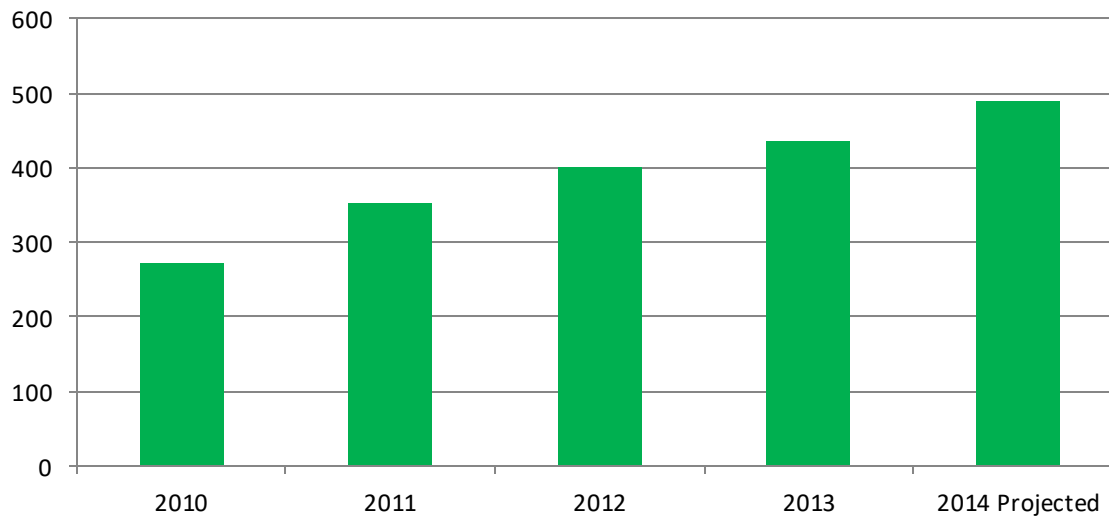
Top Countries of Origin for International Students Fall 2013



The English as a Second Language Program

- International Student/Scholar English Center – tutoring at no charge
- English for Everyday Use – informal class for scholars, spouses, students
- SPEAK test and INTL courses for graduate teaching assistants
- IEP students: 400+
 - Now about 30% matriculate into AU courses or degree programs (from 10% in 2012)
 - Serving Auburn partners

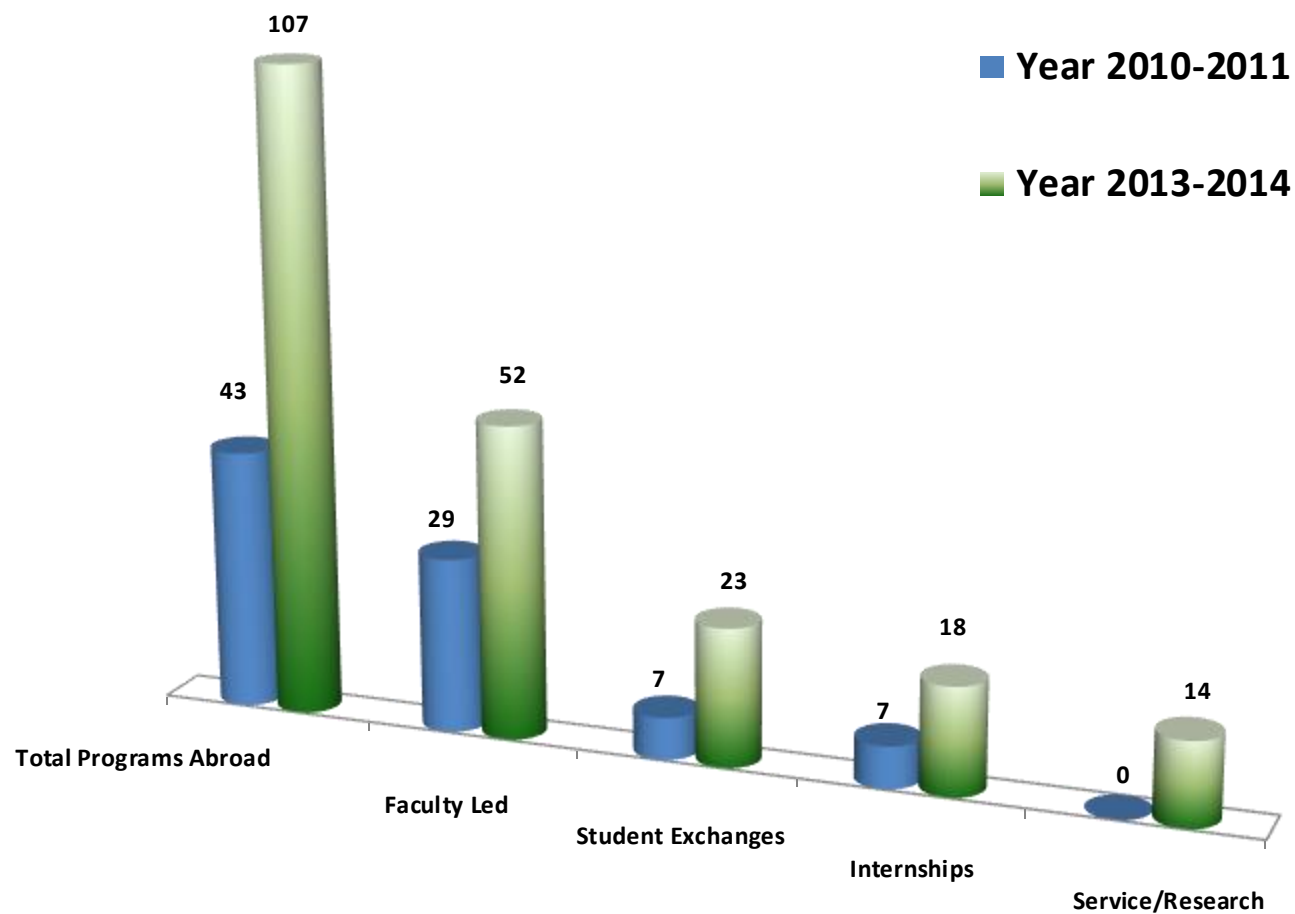

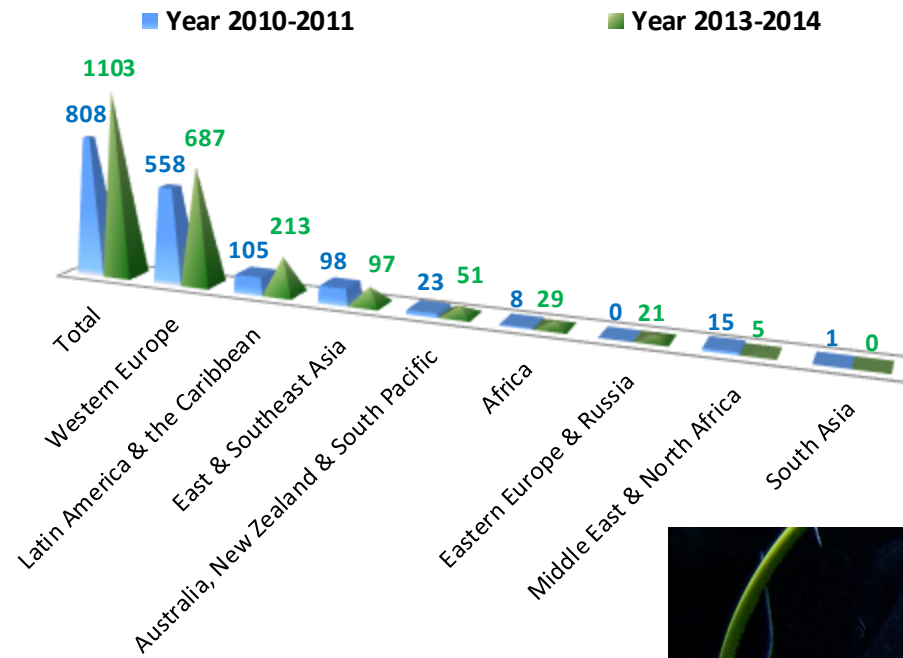

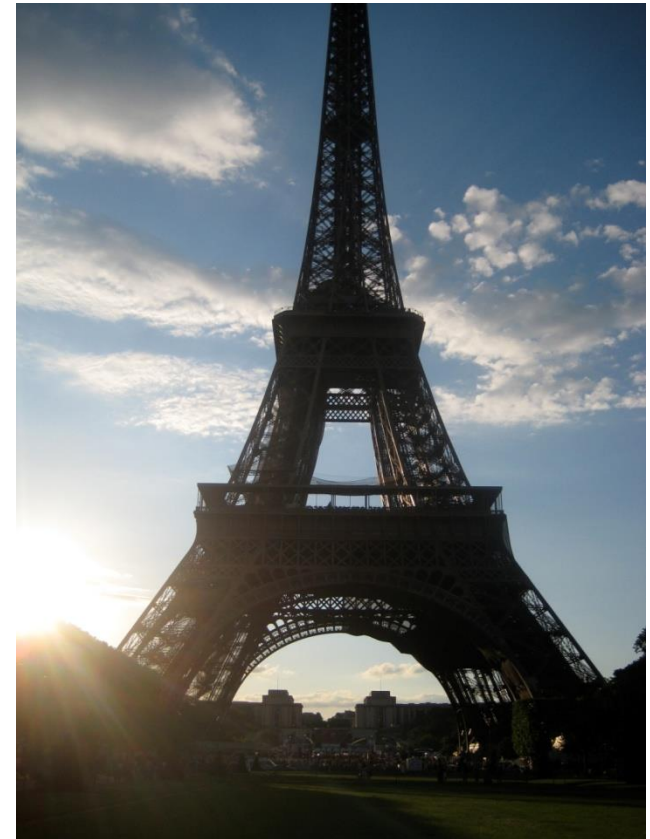
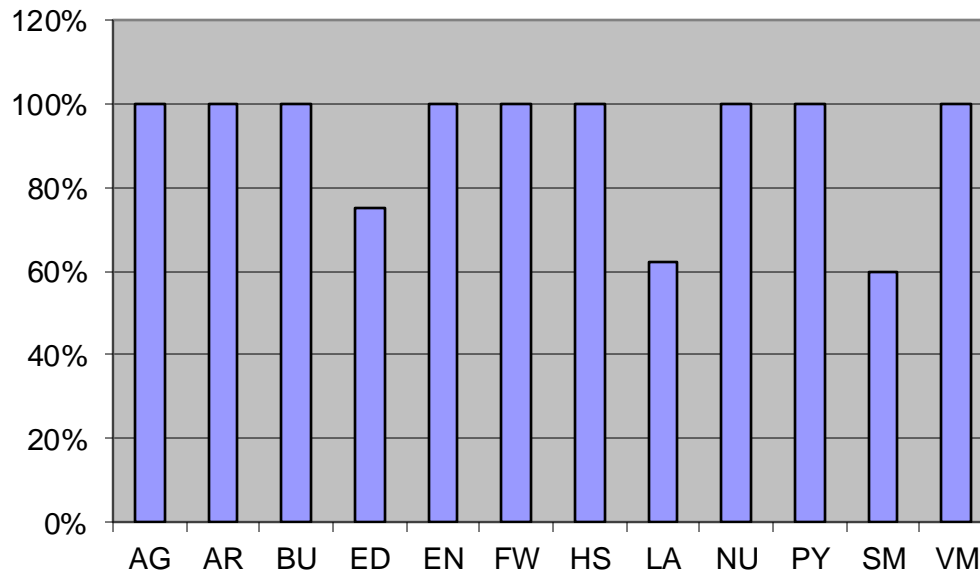
Growth in Auburn Abroad Programs By Type



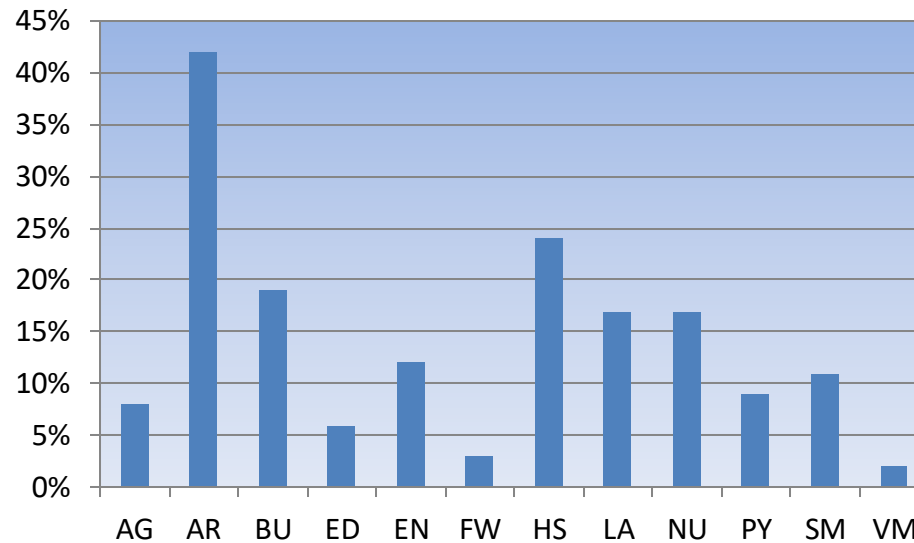
Student Participation in Programs Abroad

Undergraduate (or Professional) Study Abroad By College (Overall AU = 17%)

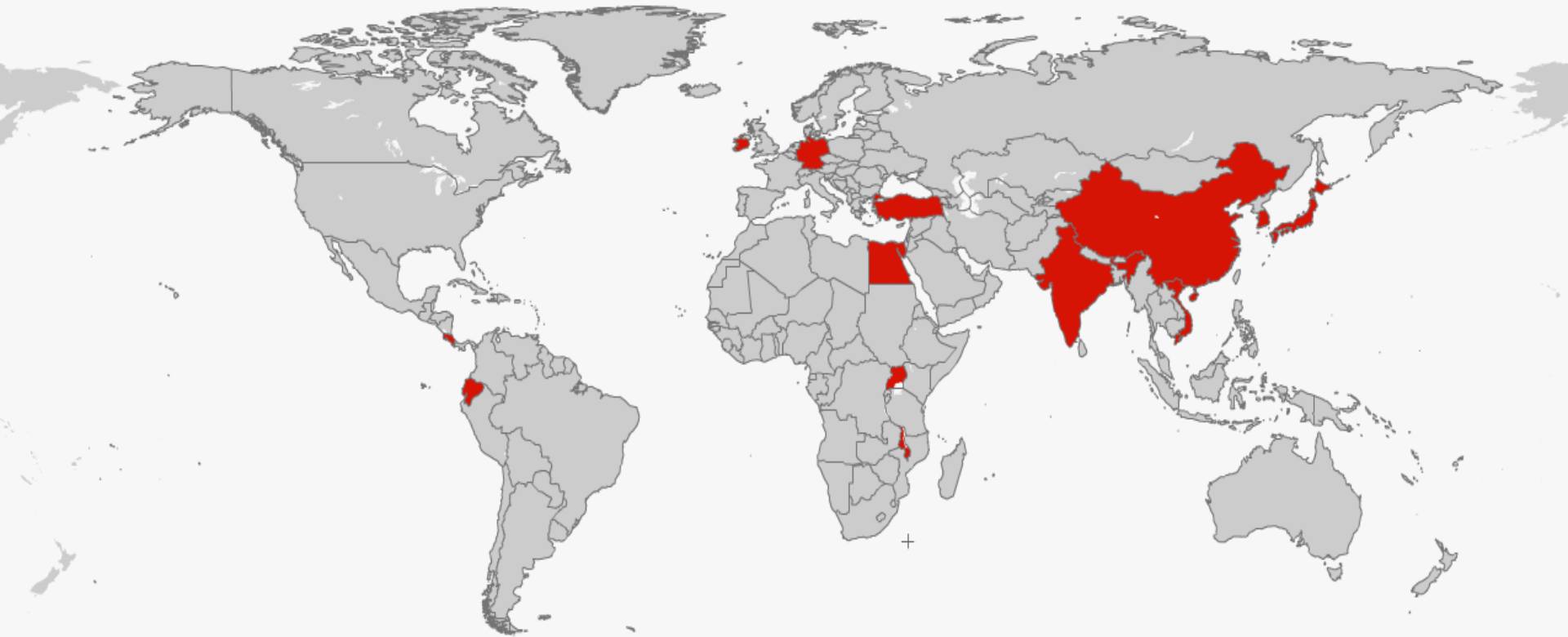

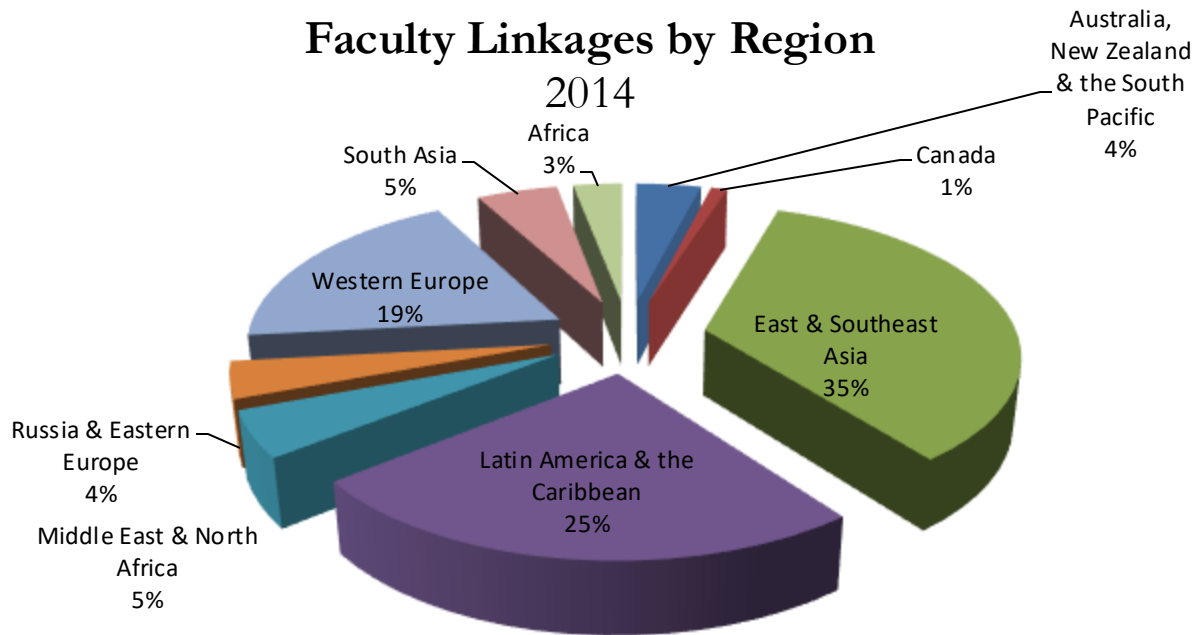

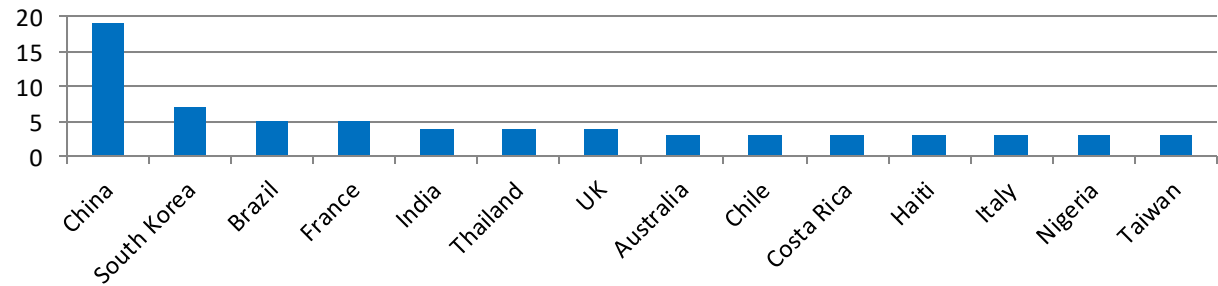


Faculty Linkages by Region

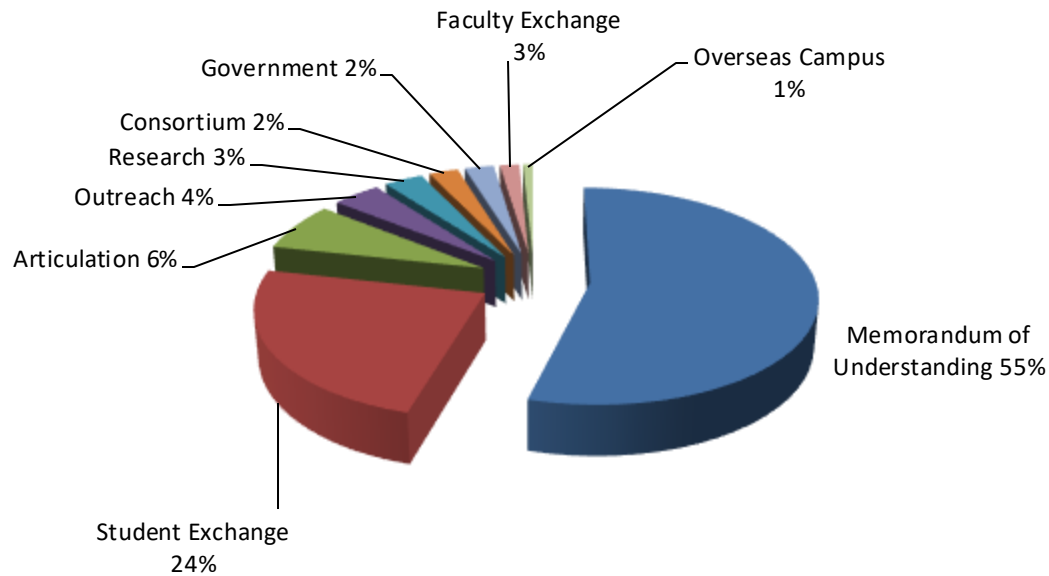

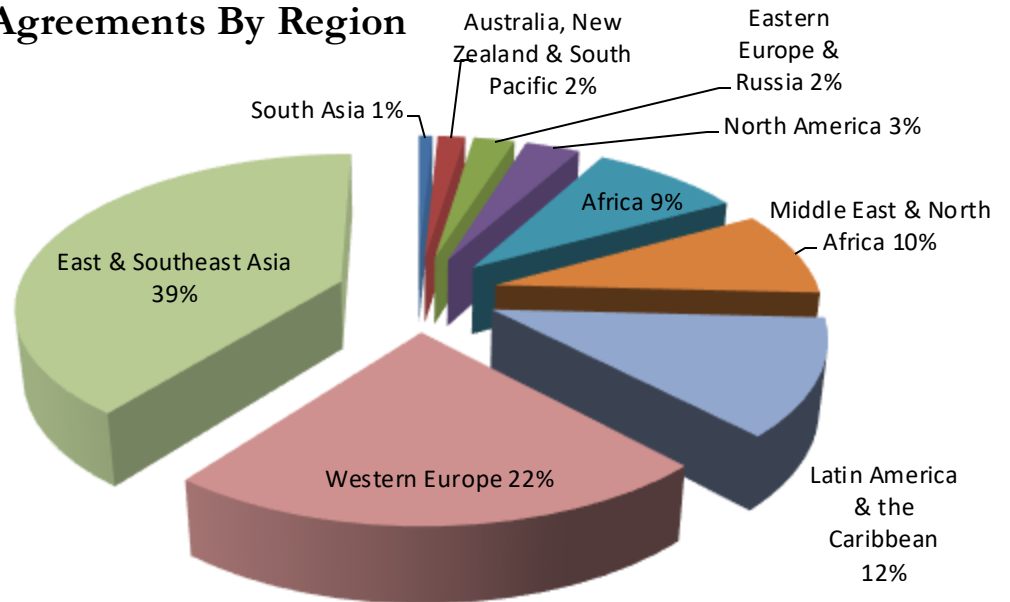
Top Countries for Faculty Linkages



International Agreements By Type

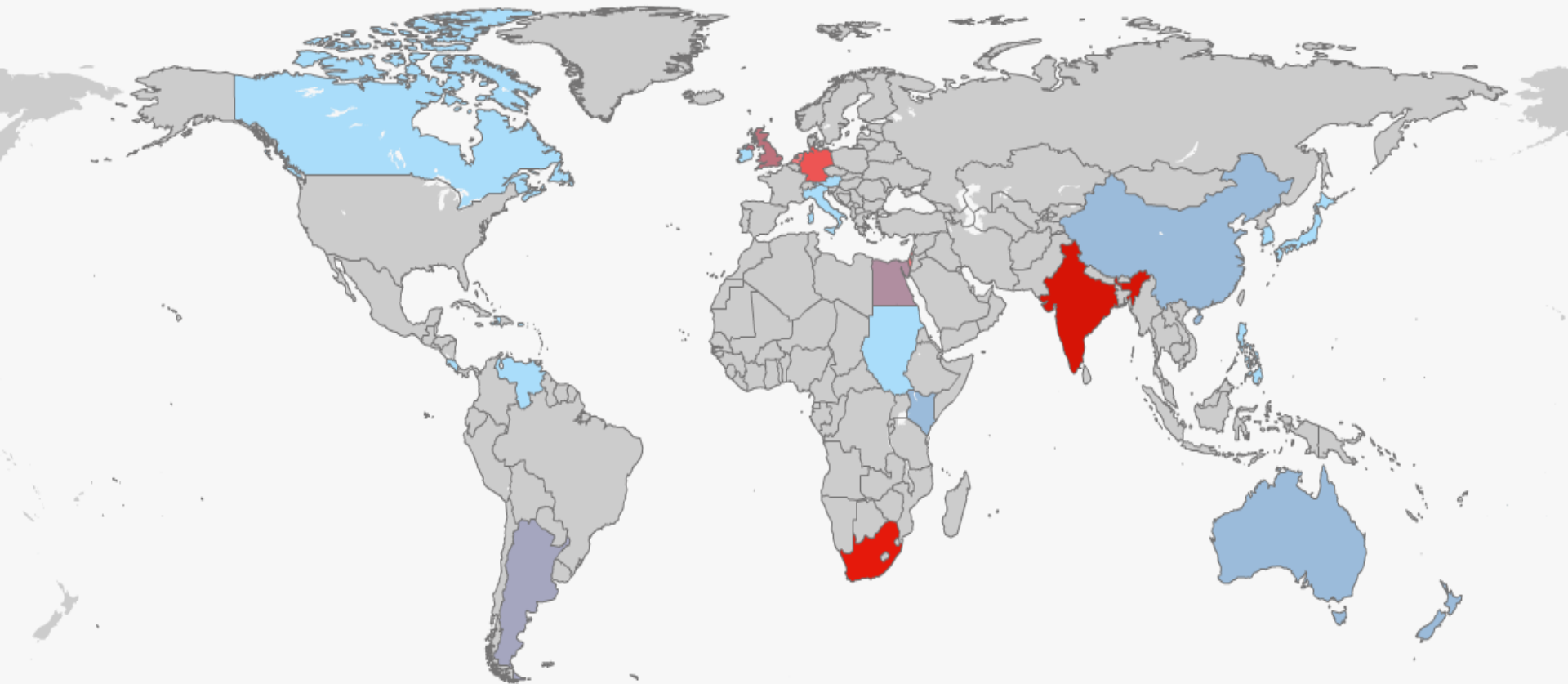

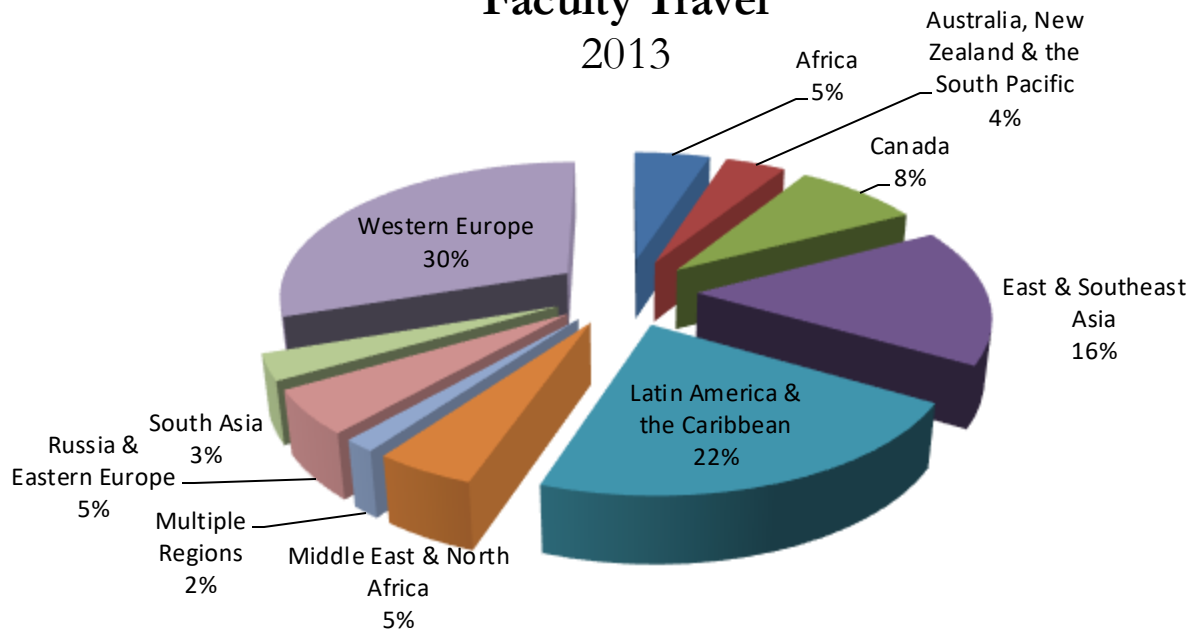

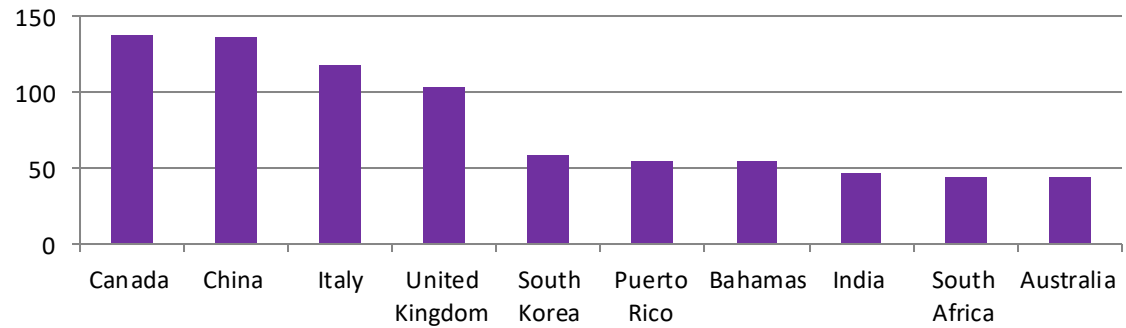
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Faculty Travel 2013
