- Streamlined, efficient process
- Increased reporting of potential violations
- Allows for greater faculty involvement during sanctioning process

- Plagiarism
- Forged excuse documents
- Exam cheating

# Suggestions for improving academic honesty

- Clarity in guidance
  - > All policies are listed on syllabus
  - > Repeated, if needed, on exams/assignments
- Confirm excuses with appropriate party
- Use the process to allow the student appropriate due diligence.
