- Serve as as an advocate, liaison or resource to students and families during times of student distress, need or emergency.





### Report an Incident or Concern

### Report a Student Academic Honesty Code Violation

Academic Honesty Code violations include, but are not limited to, cheating, aiding others in the act of cheating, falsifying, altering, or misusing a document for academic purposes, and plagiarizing others work. Note: disruptive Student Discipline violation and should be reported as a non-academic violation.

### Report Concerning or Threatening Behaviors

Auburn University students, faculty, staff and others are encouraged to report students who are struggling with academic, personal, or emotional difficulties or who may be exhibiting threatening, worrisome or other concerning behaviors.
