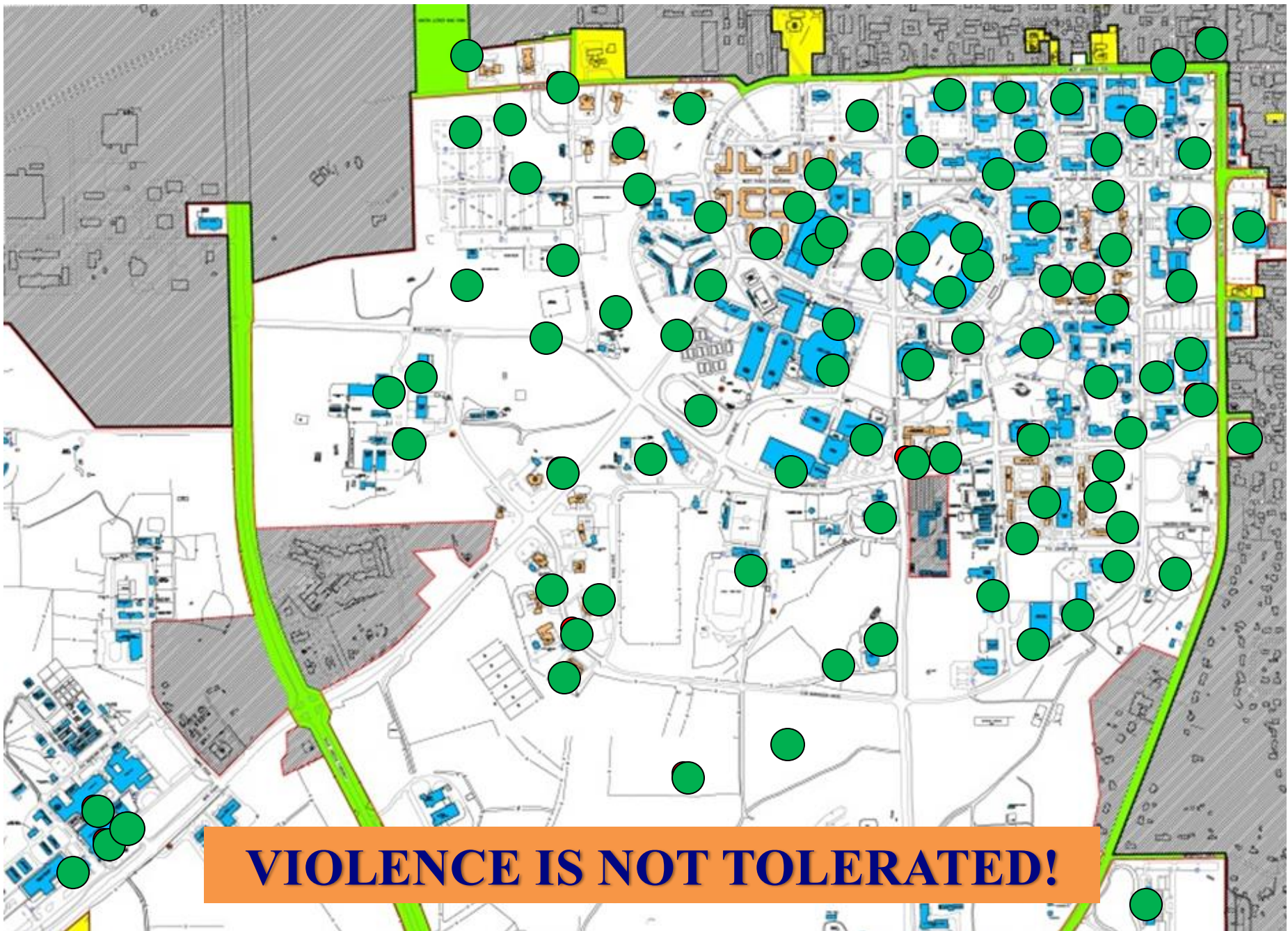
New Campus Initiative: Green Dot

- Violence prevention strategy aimed at:
 - Sexual violence
 - Dating/domestic violence
 - Stalking
- Goal – Campus culture that emphasizes:
 - We do not tolerate violence at Auburn.
 - Everyone has a role in preventing violence.



New Campus Initiative: Green Dot

- Coordinated through Office of Health Promotion & Wellness Services
- Research-based
- 5-year CDC study found:
 - 50% reduction in sexual violence
 - 40% reduction in overall power-based personal violence



VIOLENCE IS NOT TOLERATED!

Green Dot Implementation Plan

- Train Green Dot instructors
 - ~45 trained in August 2015



Green Dot Implementation Plan

- Identify peer opinion leaders
 - Provide bystander trainings
- Educate faculty & staff
- Public launch in late October
